Dangoor Walk – erection of hoardings & temporary diversions (w/c 16th March 2026 – 11th April 2026)

Ossulston Street - erection of hoardings and temporary suspension of two parking bays (13 April – for two weeks)

Dear Neighbour,

During the week of the 16 March we will commence erection of hoardings on Dangoor Walk. To undertake the work safely and in the shortest possible time Dangoor Walk will be closed from 8.00am - 4.30pm daily. An alternative route via Brill Place will be sign posted.

The completed hoarding will close the footpath which bypasses the existing gas compound and as a result Dangoor Walk will be closed during gas deliveries to the Francis Crick Institute. Currently three gas deliveries a week are planned each week meaning the closure of Dangoor Walk between 8.00am and 11.00am on those days. An alternative route via Brill Place will be sign posted during these times.



From Monday 13 April we will install hoardings on Ossulston Street. This will mean that we must temporarily close the pavement during the working day and suspend two parking bays to safely facilitate the works. Please look out for the advance warning signs.

We also intend to commence some localised investigation works at the existing gabion wall and the stone staircase in Ossulston Street. These works will require some narrowing of the footpath for a limited period of time.
